Liberty Parks and Rec is In Search Of: Lifeguards, Bitty Sports/Camp Supervisor, Concession attendants and more!

LIBERTY Mo. – The Liberty Parks and Recreation Department is gearing up for spring and summer and will be looking for some fun, energetic folks to join the team.

ISO: Individuals who enjoy working in a fun, often boisterous, environment, indoors and outdoors and who are certified by the National Pool and Waterpark Lifeguard Training Program (NPWLTP).

Parks and Rec isn't hiring *lifeguards* quite yet, but they are offering three lifeguard certification classes to provide the training and certification needed to apply for lifeguard positions at the Liberty Community Center and many area neighborhood, country club and community swimming pools.

The department contracts with Ellis & Associates, Inc., to offer NPWLTP certification and recertification courses. Local swimming pools will soon be looking to hire individuals who have already completed a lifeguard program. Don't wait until the last minute to get certified as a lifeguard and miss the opportunity for a great summer job!

Before registering, please check with the facility in which you wish to apply to confirm it accepts this certification. Participants must be at least 15 years old at the time of the course. Lifeguards at the Liberty Community Center must hold an NPWLTP certification. Last year, of the 64 participants who completed the certification program, 38 were hired by the Liberty Community Center. Others went on to work at the Liberty Hills and Clayview country clubs.

- Spinal management.
- How to use an AED and supplemental oxygen.
- Water-rescue skills.
- How to anticipate, recognize and respond to an aquatic emergency.
