Free Liberty Summer Band Concerts dates set

LIBERTY, Mo. – It must be summer – it's almost time for the Liberty Summer Band's free Tuesday evening concerts in historic downtown Liberty.

For more than 40 years, the Liberty Summer Band has provided free Tuesday evening concerts in the month of June. The band is comprised of volunteer musicians from Liberty and some surrounding communities and plays a wide selection of marches, pops, jazz and Broadway show tunes.

The concerts begin at 7:30 p.m. on the historic Liberty Square outside the Rooney Justice Center, 11 South Water St. Concert dates are June 9, 16 and 30. No concert on June 23. Concert-goers are encouraged to bring lawn chairs or blankets. In the event of rain, concerts take place inside the Liberty Community Center, 1600 Withers Road.

Their final concert is on July 4, part of Liberty4thFest celebrations. This concert features patriotic music just before the fireworks display at Greene Stadium on the William Jewell College campus.

The Liberty Summer Band is conducted by Shane Fuller, band director at Liberty North High School. Liberty City Clerk David Fulk returns as the band's concert host.

Anyone who plays a concert band instrument is welcome to be in the band. Rehearsals are the night before each concert, 7-9 p.m., at Liberty North High School.
