- **Kids' Day Camp:** Focusing on an active lifestyle, this full day camp teaches the basic fundamentals of sports and exercise techniques through a variety of games and activities!
- **LEGO Camps:** In partnership with Play-Well Teknologies, LEGO camps encourage campers to pursue their naturally gifted creator side. Each kid will dive into the massive collection of LEGO's to build elaborate objects, structures and vehicles by exploring the fundamental principles of engineering and physics
- **Spanish Language Project:** The Language Project flight crew takes your campers on a summer camp ride visiting Spanish speaking countries, learning the language and the culture all in this jam packed camp. Immersion Passport is a travel themed Spanish language learning camp that will teach your child Spanish while also adding in FUN new vocabulary, games, crafts, culture and excitement about another language and country.
