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Liberty Silver Center to host free Medicare Counseling

LIBERTY, Mo. – With open enrollment for Medicare fast approaching, the Liberty Silver Center has teamed up with Missouri CLAIM, a state program for Missourians on Medicare, to provide free, objective Medicare insurance counseling and assistance to area Medicare beneficiaries by appointment.

A trained volunteer will be available to talk with current and future Medicare recipients about the ins and outs of Medicare at the Liberty Silver Center by appointment between 9 a.m.–1 p.m. on Sept. 8.

“We’re excited about this new opportunity. By working with CLAIM, our community will have access to some of the best-trained Medicare experts out there to help people understand this program,” said LeAnn Lawlor, Community Services Manager.

With Medicare open enrollment taking place Oct. 15–Dec. 7, CLAIM volunteers also will be available by appointment between 9 a.m.–1 p.m. every Tuesday, October through December. For individuals who are new to Medicare, the CLAIM consultant will help you sort through the different plans and determine the optimal plan. Current Medicare recipients are also encouraged to visit with a CLAIM representative. Changes in your plan or prescription benefits may have occurred.

CLAIM was founded in 1993 and has helped Missourians save millions in out-of-pocket expenses by helping beneficiaries understand their Medicare benefits and by providing

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enrollment assistance. CLAIM receives financial assistance from the Administration for Community Living and the Missouri Department of Insurance. Services are provided by Primaris, a Columbia-based non-profit.

This service is provided by appointment only between the hours of 9 a.m.-1 p.m. Individuals will have an opportunity to spend 45 minutes with the trained volunteer representative to discuss all of their Medicare questions.
