I. Approval of Meeting Summary: September 10, 2020

Commissioner Stilfield made a motion to approve the meeting summary as presented the motion was seconded by Commissioner Young. Motion passed 6-0-0.

II. Current Business

Wall of Love Update- Commissioner Steinbeck will take on this project when time allows. Commissioner Wyman will connect with his art club and connect with Amy to create a timeline.

Sculpture Update- Staff reported that she is working on updates to the Oto Cast App and the brochures etc.

Sertoma Relocation of their pavers- Chairman Immelt asked if any of the Commissioners had any suggestions for where they might relocate the pavers since our last meeting. Commissioner Stilfield said he would like to see them in a high traffic area. Commissioner Wyman said around the George Washington statue on Mill Street might be a nice location. Commissioner Wyman said it would be interesting to have our local Great Americans with the Great Americans Statues.

Other Business

Art Partner Reports:

Liberty Arts Foundation- No report

Library- Commissioner McDonald took us on a virtual tour through the new library. Melissa Stan will coordinate the process for scheduling new artists. Melissa will reach out to Commissioner Wyman to coordinate when they are ready and open to the public. He knows there are artists that interested in exhibiting there. Chairman Immelt said the Urban Sketchers are interested in the space to display their work. They are working with the schools and the archives also.

William Jewell – Commissioner Wyman reported that they had an outdoor opera performance during the cool nights last week. The attendees were outside and socially distanced. They are working on an online choral piece. The pep band will have their first performance during a football scrimmage. They are planning to do a George Orwell play, only available to the on campus community. The gallery is closed. They did set up a photo gallery with the medium and dimensions.

Corbin Theatre – Commissioner Stilfield asked about the Cares Act Funding for Music. Staff will follow up and ask. Commissioner Stilfield said the Corbin Theatre is in the process of moving to the Garrison Cultural Center. They need to set up lighting for the theatre, a sound booth and equipment, microphones etc. They will build out the stage and Nathan has graciously agreed to help. They plan to open up with social distancing protocols in place. They hope to be done with the move by the end of October.

Norterre- No Report

Liberty Public Schools- Commissioner Money reported that they are resuming productions in a different format. They have hired a company to film performances. Limited audiences are available to the parents of seniors only. The musical is a non-traditional musical, students are writing the scripts. Concerts will resume in December, being videoed also. Elementary performances are on hold until Spring.
