The Jewell City Five band may do a Christmas concert but he doesn’t have the details or confirmation.
- e. Liberty Public Schools - Commissioner Brown reported that *The Little Mermaid* will be sat LHS. They went to the show last night but every other performance is sold out. At North they are getting ready for *Into the Woods* that opens next week.
