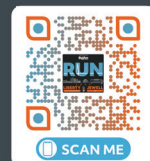

FILING FOR THE 2023 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Every two years, elections are held for the City of Liberty mayoral seat, four City Council seats (one from each ward) and four honorary positions. The next municipal election will be held April 4, 2023.

2023 Election Information:

The municipal offices included in the April 4, 2023 election are Mayor, Ward I Council Member, Ward II Council Member, Ward III Council Member and Ward IV Council Member.

The honorary positions included in this election are City Clerk, City Treasurer, City Constable and City Auditor.

How to File for Municipal Office:

Qualified individuals can file for office in person beginning at 8 a.m. on Dec. 6 through 4:30 p.m. on Dec. 27. Filing will take place at the Administration Department window at Liberty City Hall, located at 101 E. Kansas St. Candidates may file anytime during posted business hours. Current posted hours are 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. (Hours subject to change). Please note that City Hall will be closed in observance of the Christmas holiday on Dec. 26.

Candidates will fill out a Declaration of Candidacy and provide a photo ID to the Deputy City Clerk. No person may file for more than one position, and only the first filed application shall be accepted, unless the candidate files a written Declaration of Withdrawal.

MAYOR & CITY COUNCIL

Qualifications:

- Be a citizen of the State of Missouri
- Be at least 21 years old
- Have resided within the City of Liberty city limits for two years preceding the election date
- Be a registered voter in Liberty
- Council Members must also be residents in the ward for which they are running.

Terms:

The City of Liberty Mayor is elected to a two-year term. City of Liberty Council Members are elected to four-year terms.

Compensation:

- Mayor - \$4,800 per year
- Council Member - \$2,400 per year
- Both the Mayor and City Council Members are eligible for full coverage health insurance through the City of Liberty.

HONORARY ELECTED OFFICIALS

In addition to Mayoral and City Council seats, there are four honorary positions that are open for election every two years. Those interested in filing for the honorary positions of City Clerk and City Treasurer must meet the same qualifications as outlined for Mayor and City Council. Candidates for the honorary City Constable and City Auditor must be registered, qualified voters in the City of Liberty.

Terms:

All honorary elected officials serve two-year terms.


Compensation:

Honorary elected positions earn one dollar for each year served.
